## **Sue Kruse Scholarship**

- Sue Kruse was for many years a Uniform Parent for the Marchmasters and a diligent worker for the Valley Band program. Sue passed away due to breast cancer at the age of 51 on November 27, 2006.
- \$1000 scholarship has been established to reward a senior band member who best exemplifies Sue's love and spirit for the band.
- Each scholarship awarded must be used to offset tuition costs of the student's first year of secondary education. This will include college, community college, or trade school. The award will be sent directly to the winner's educational institution by the Band Booster Treasurer.
- Scholarship Criteria Appliant must:
- Be a senior concert band student at Valley High School
   Complete an essay of 500 words or less
   Be accepted to an accredited undergraduate program or trade school

# **Sue Kruse Scholarship**

• Essay Criteria

Applicant is to submit an essay of 500 words or less describing their band experience and explain how being a member of the band has added to the quality of their academic endeavors and their high school experience.

Copies of the essays will be provided to the scholarship committee (with the student's name removed) for consideration. At the request of the Kruse family, the committee is appointed by the Booster board and includes a current member of the board and two individuals that no longer have children in the program, but were active in the past in band activities. The decision of the committee is final. Late submissions will not be considered.
